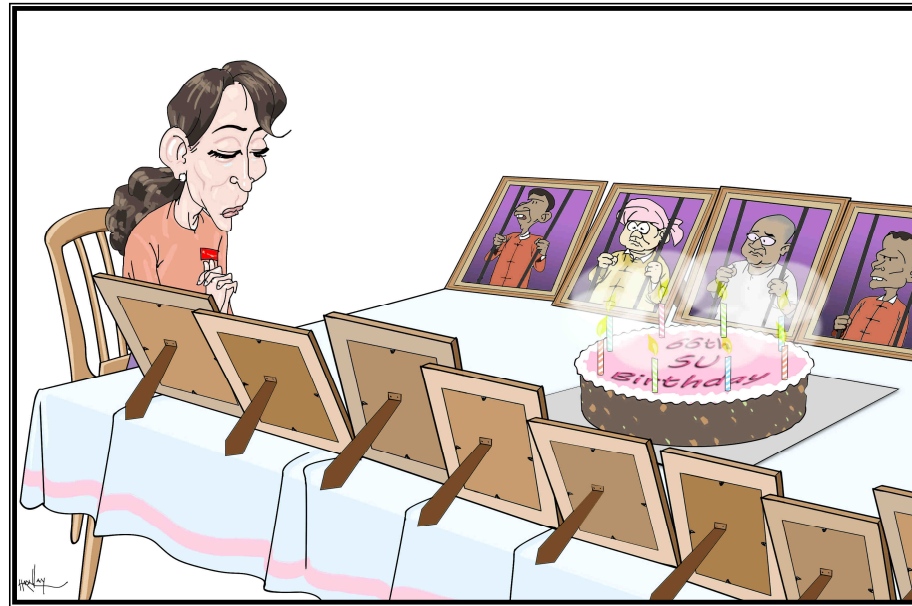


Come and celebrate with us Aung San Suu Kyi's 66th birthday!



Aung San Suu Kyi, who has become a symbol of the Burmese people's struggle for democracy, will turn 66 this year. Unlike in previous years, this time she will not spend her birthday under house arrest as her punishment finally came to an end. She was released last year a short time after the parliamentary elections in Burma, as part of the Burmese military junta's effort to divert the attention of Burmese people and the international community from the vast manipulation of the elections. At her birthday party this year she will still miss more than 2,000 Burmese political prisoners, many of them her close friends and colleagues, who remain in squalid prisons across the country.

Come and celebrate Aung San Suu Kyi's birthday with us, show your solidarity with Burmese political prisoners and demonstrate to Burma's rulers that Aung San Suu Kyi has friends not only in Burmese prisons but also across the world.
