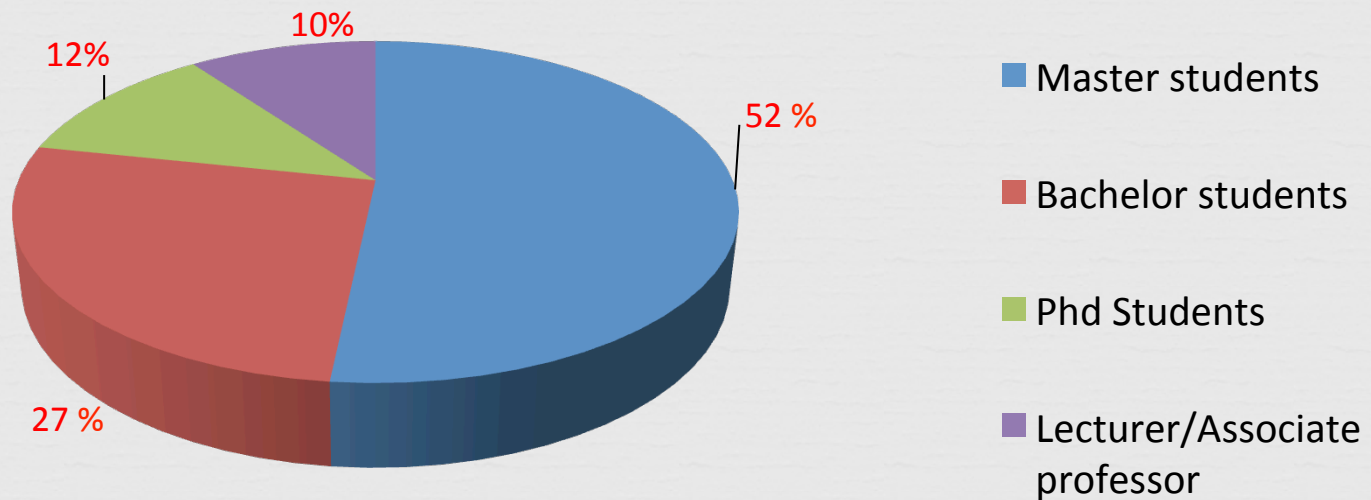

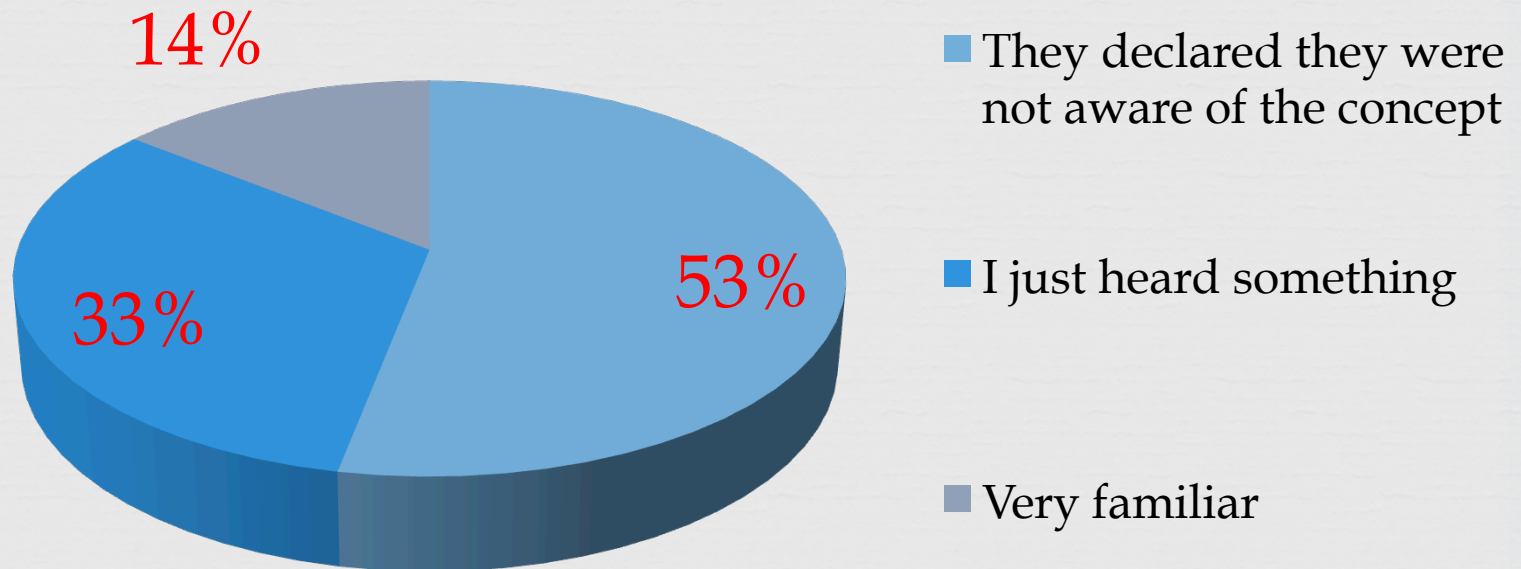

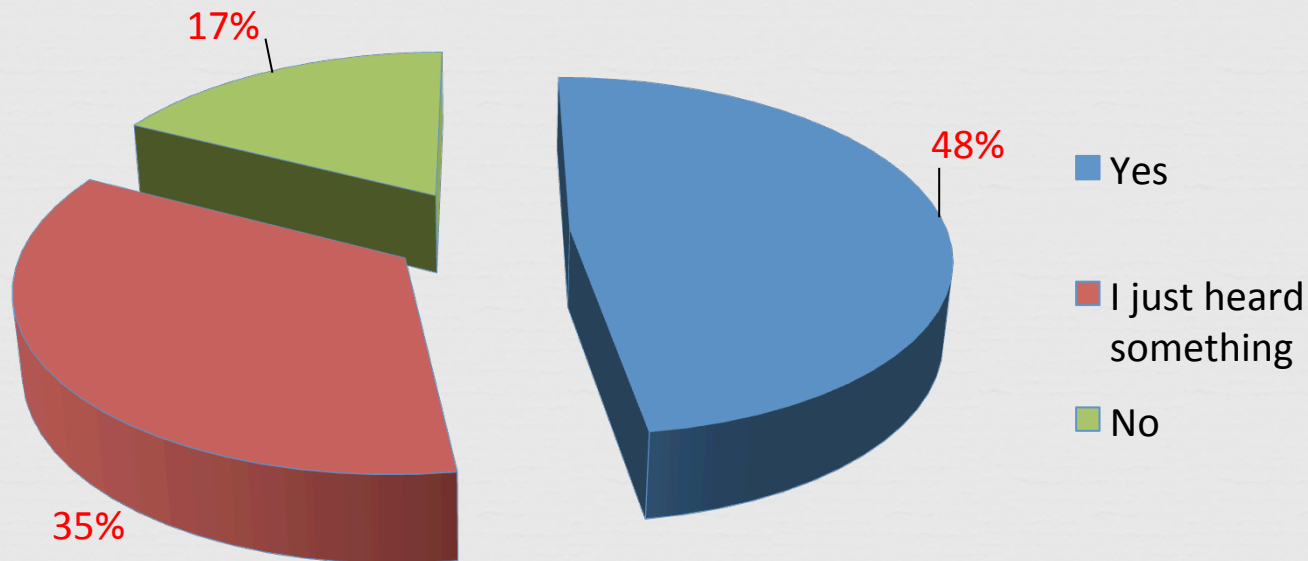

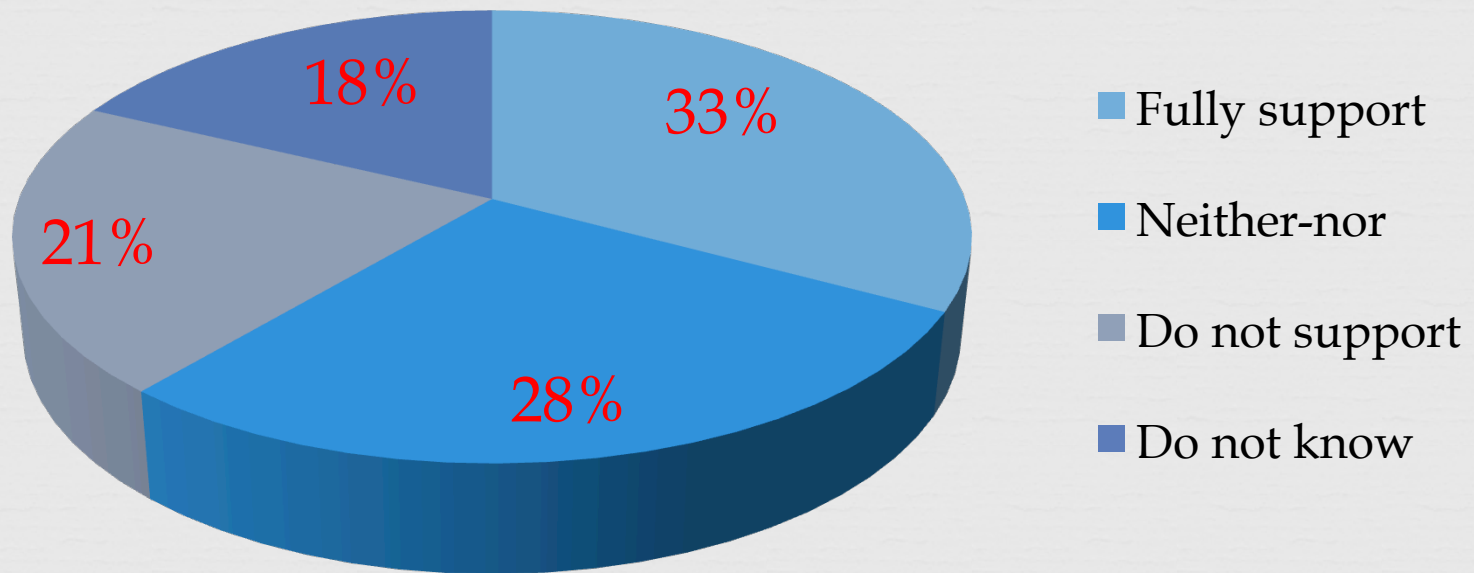
Your level of knowledge of E- Government concept in RM N=2160, CBS AXA, 2013



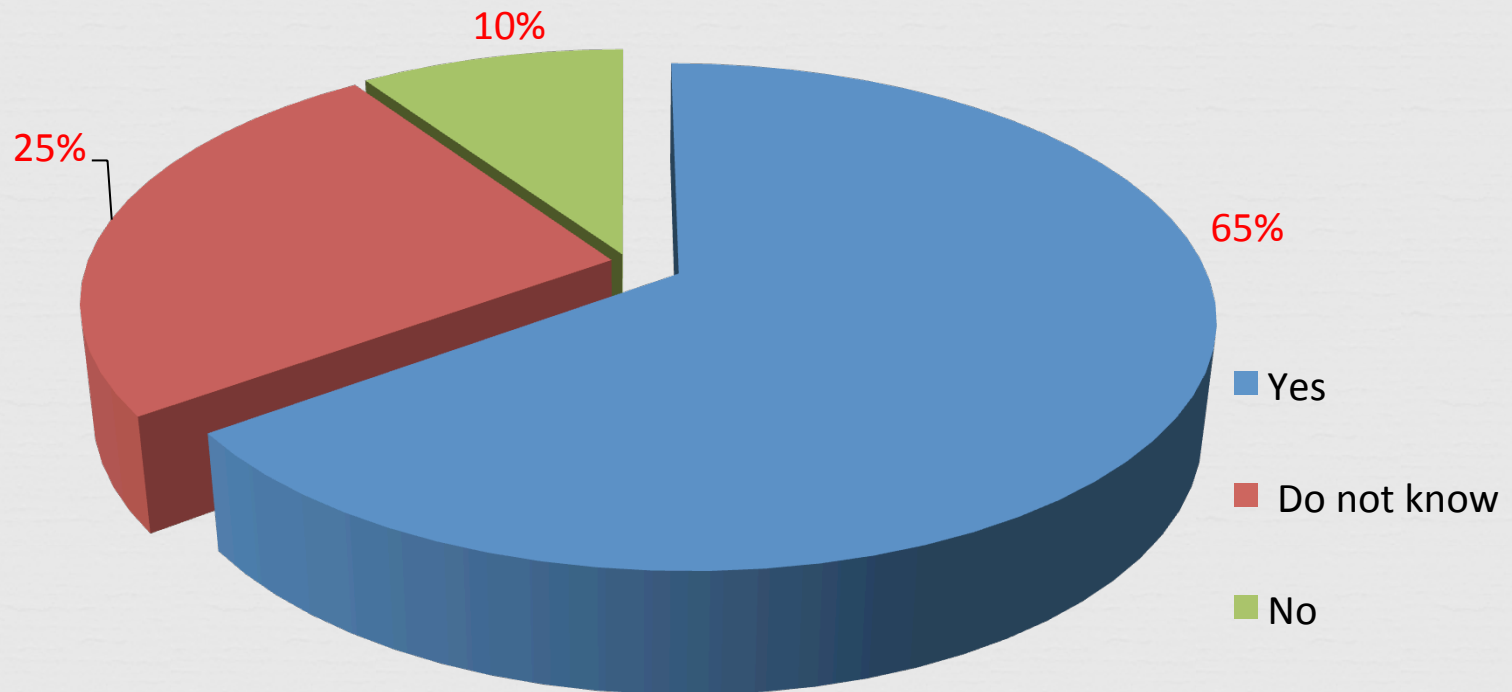
1. Do you know about E-Government in Georgia?



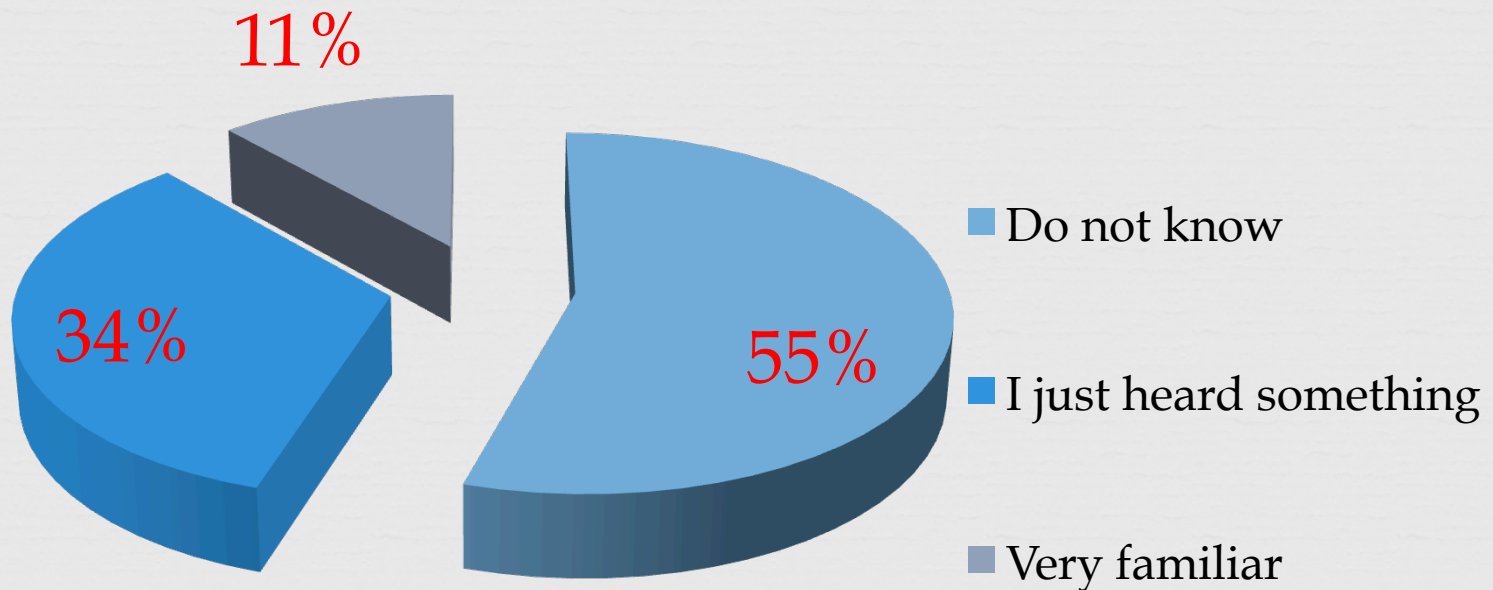
Comparative assessment of the level of support for implementing the e-Government in RM? %



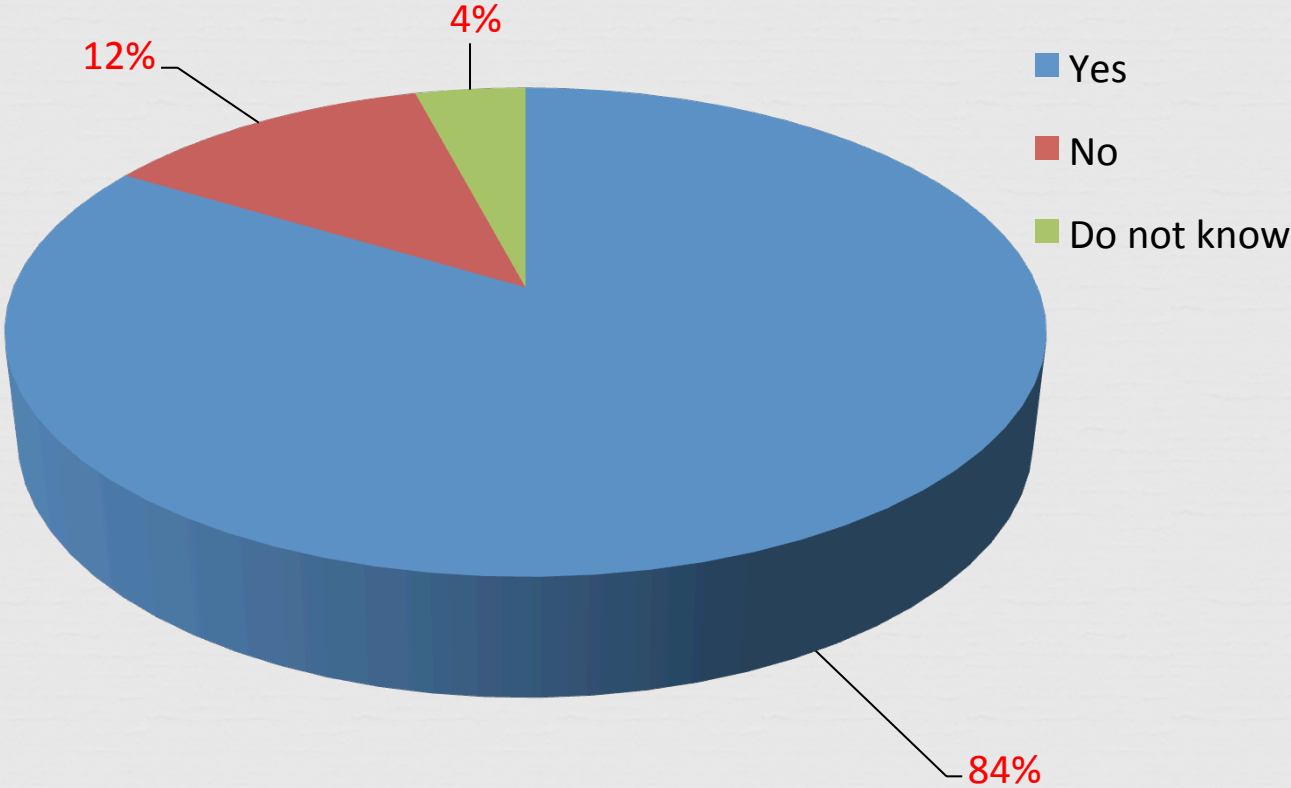

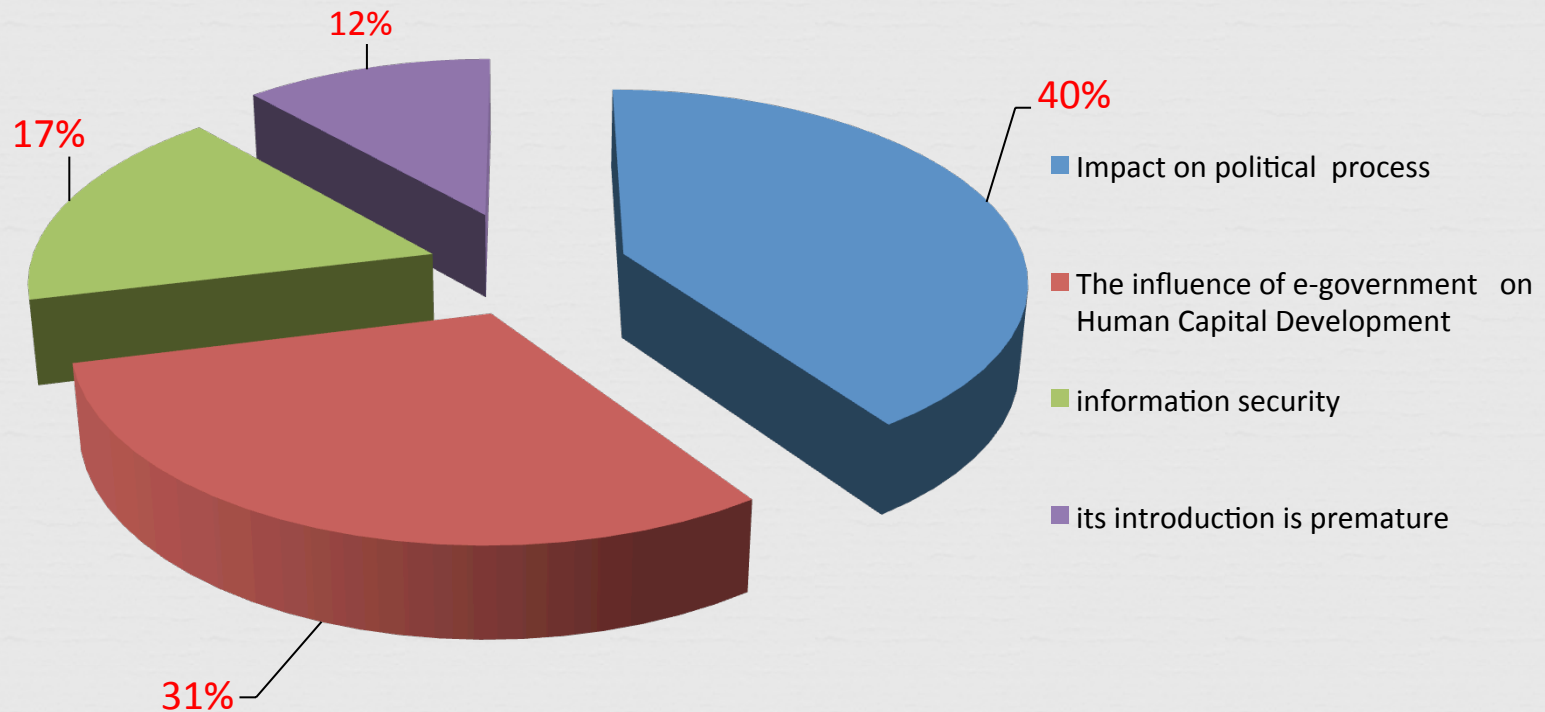
Opinions of the potential advantages/benefits of e-Government? (Republic of Moldova)



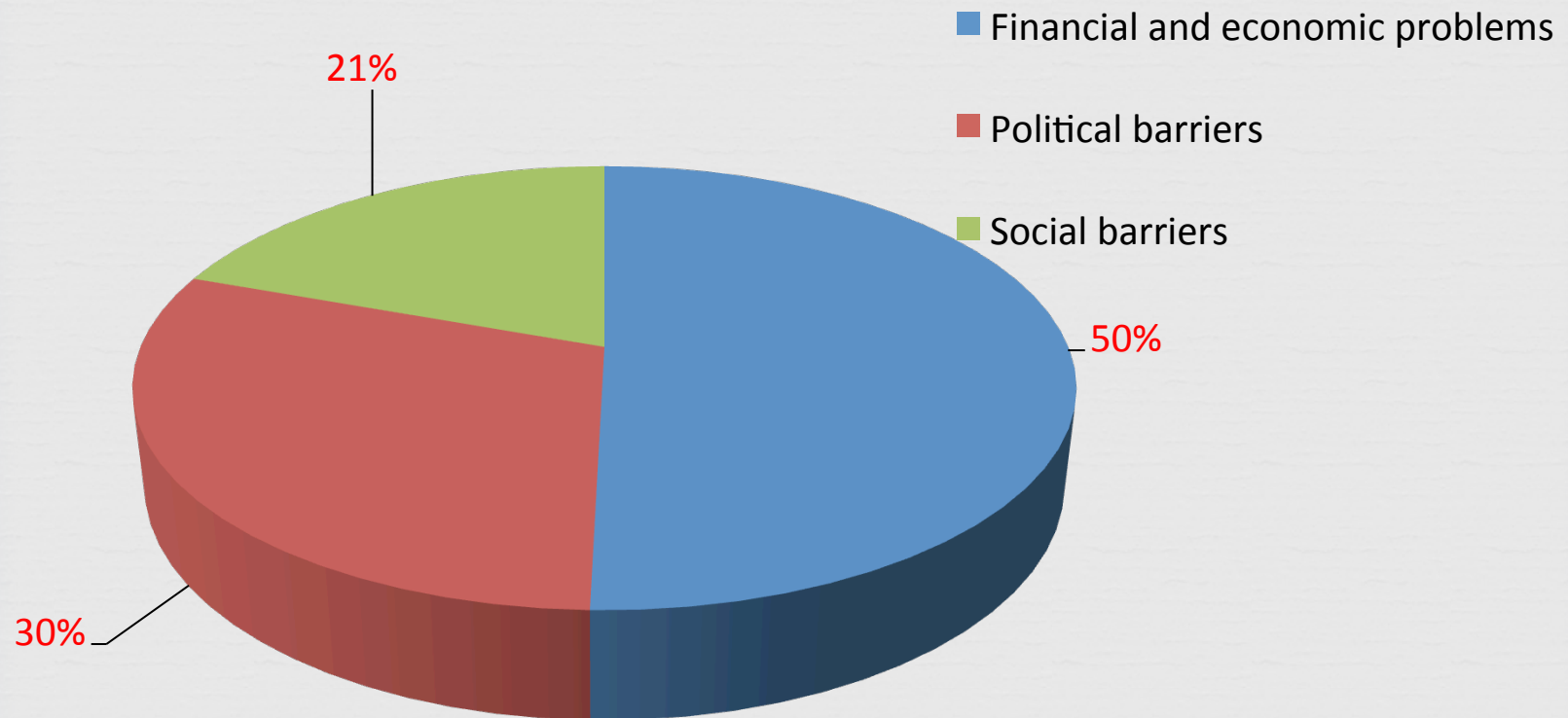

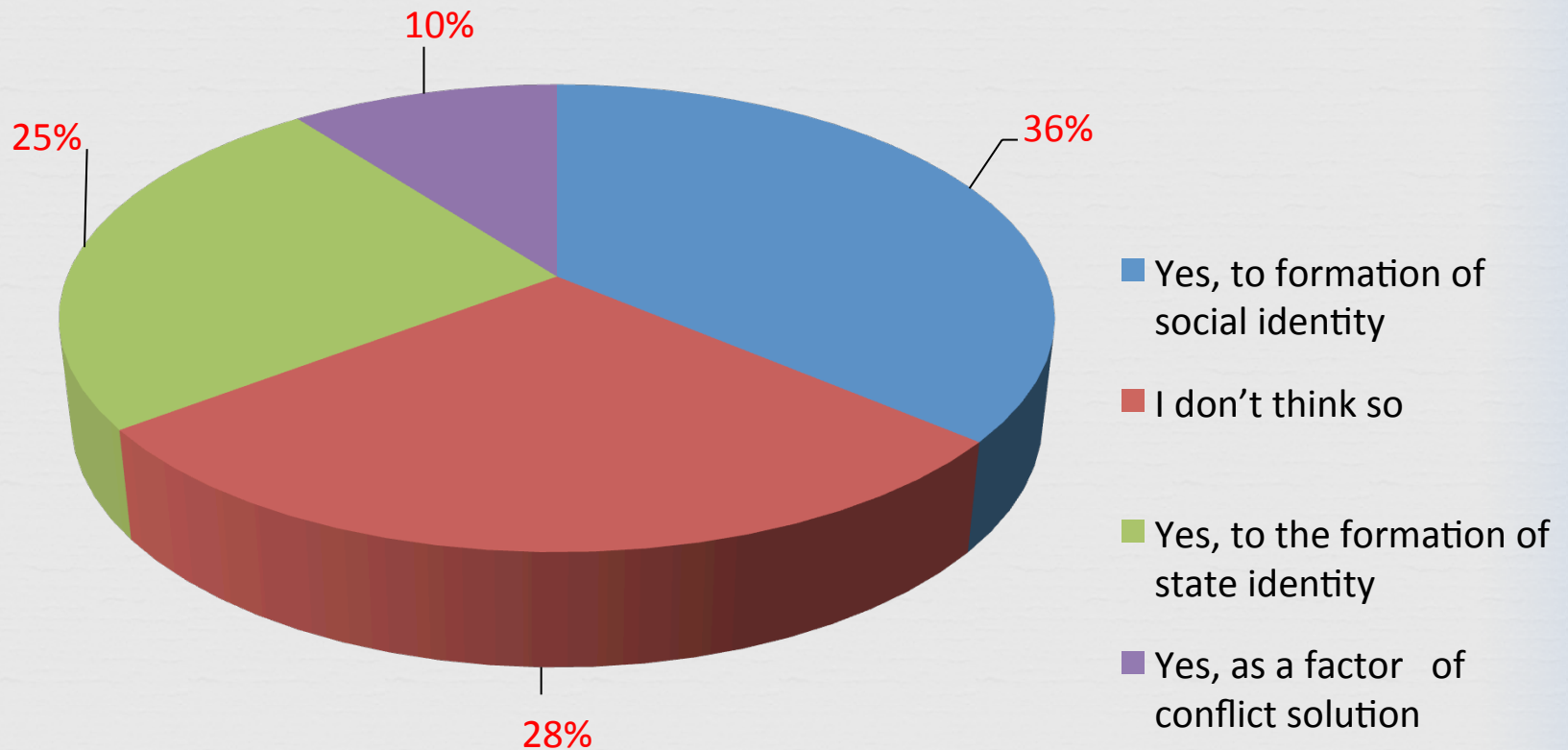

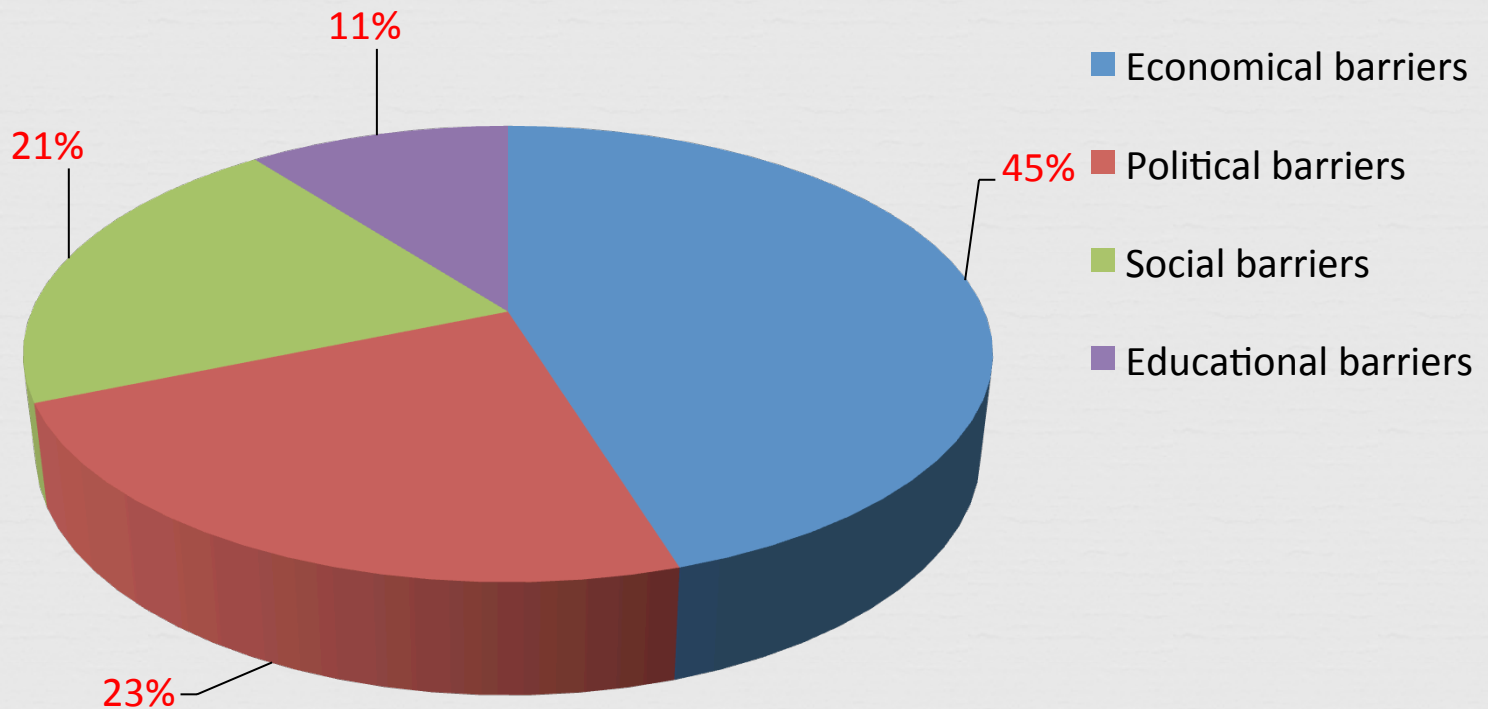
